#### **About Us**

AsanSka University College of Design and Technology is a reputable practice-based institution, located at Oyibi in the Greater Accra Region, Ghana, and accredited by the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission (GTEC) and affiliated with the University of Education, Winneba.



### **Entry Requirements**

#### **DEGREE**

- (i) WASSCE & SSSCE Candidates Candidates must have six credits (A1-C6) in English, Mathematics and Integrated Science (Biology or Agricultural Science for International Applicants) or Social Studies, and three electives subjects, making an aggregate of 36 or better in WASSCE and 24 or better in SSSCE.
- (ii) Mature Applicants Candidates are required to write and pass an entrance examination which will be conducted by the University College. Mature applicants must be 25 years and above at the time of application.
- (iii) GCE Advanced Level Candidates Passes in three (3) subjects (at least one of the passes should be Grade D or better). Also, the applicant must have had credit passes (Grade 6) in five GCE Ordinary Level subjects including English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject (for non-science students) and an Arts subject (for Science students).
- (iv) HND Holders Applicant must have graduated with a good HND certificate (i.e. at least 2nd Class Lower Division). In addition, the applicant must have acquired a 2-year post-HND qualification working experience.
- **(v) International Applicants** All international qualifications will be referred to the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission (GTEC) for determination of equivalences and eligibility for admission.
- (vi) Other Professional Qualifications ICA, ACCA, CIM may contact us for admission placement.





#### **DIPLOMA ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS**

#### SSSCE Holders

- 1. Six (6) Passes (A -D) in all subjects, including English and Mathematics.
- 2. For areas of specialisation, three (3) of the Passes must be in relevant subjects.

#### **WASSCE Holders**

- 1. Six (6) Passes (A1 D7) in all subjects, three (3) of which should be credit Passes (C6) or better.
- 2. It must be noted, however, that certain courses may require credit passes (C6) or better, in other relevant courses.
